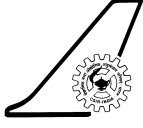
The process of identifying technologies will be through targeted Needs Assessment Surveys in each TECHVIL that prioritize community needs and map these to technology solutions.

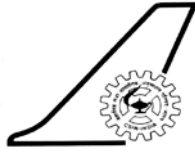

INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Agencies –NGOs/Institutions with skills, capacities and experience in conducting Needs Assessment Survey (NAS) for identification of community needs in particular and interested in undertaking a similar exercise for the CSIR-800, are invited to submit their application. The terms of reference for the assignment are given below.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

BACKGROUND:

"CSIR for Society: The CSIR-800 Program" is the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research's contribution to India meeting the Millennium Development Goals. CSIR-800 will deploy needed technologies in 25 village clusters across India with the objective of augmenting the incomes and improving the quality of lives of the relevant communities.

The program would focus on developing technologies to:

- Gainfully employ farmers to improve their economic status through solution based employment generation
- Utilize various types of wastes and develop useful products
- Reduce drudgery through low-cost energy efficient products
- Cater to the needs of standard as well as region specific housing and construction.
- Bring affordable health to the poor
- Ensure the availability of potable water to rural population
- Promote products that use natural renewable energy sources

CSIR-800 will start its intervention in the field with the identification of community needs, focusing on the seven themes mentioned above. As part of the process of NAS, CSIR-800 is facilitating the selection of suitable Agencies in undertaking the task of conducting NAS.

NEEDS ASSESSMENT SURVEY:

Needs Assessment survey will be taken up in three phases spread across the period of 5 years:

- **PHASE-I: Initial Survey- Quantitative Assessment** - To establish the NEEDS within each of the TECHVILs, a thorough and deep study of community needs will be done in the initial survey. For authenticity and accuracy in the assessment results, the data in the initial phase will be collected

from the review of available literature and enlisting the community needs. Afterwards focused group discussion will be organized at comprehensive level in each of the TEHVIL to check the relevance of the enlisted needs and their prioritization by the community members themselves. This survey will serve as a baseline to establish the present scenario in terms of the community needs and will set the benchmarks for making comparison and evaluating the impact of the project in the final survey.

- **PHASE II: Intermediate Survey - Quantitative Assessment & Data Analysis:** The actual surveys will be conducted in this phase with the specified sample size. To fortify the results of initial survey and to dig into specific need areas further, intermediate survey will ensure the collection of data through interviews using the customized questionnaires based on the prioritization of community needs. Questionnaires will be finalized by CSIR-800 in consultation with distinguished sociologists, economists and institutions.
- **PHASE III: Final Survey** – Towards the end of the programme, a final survey will be conducted to assess how technological interventions have improved the life of the people.

SCOPE OF WORK:

The agency selected for conducting NAS will be designated as ‘TECHNICAL SUPPORT ORGANIZATION’ (TSO). Its overall scope of work is:

- Collection of data on the local needs through the process of 'Focused Group Discussion' and interview as required in different phases of NAS.
- Compilation and analysis of data.
- Detailed documentation of the process of 'Needs Assessment Survey' including the results and recommendations in each phase.
- Generation of measurable and tangible evidences agreed as per the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with CSIR-800.

PROPOSED STATE, DISTRICT AND PANCHAYATS:

The selected Agency is supposed to work in any 4 of the following 23 villages of Tumkur district of Karnataka:

The applicant should be a legal entity with a valid registration identity and also hold financial credentials. CSIR-800 will be looking forward to the following expertise from the organisations proposing to implement the assignment:

- Demonstrable experience of conducting similar exercises such as data collection, compilation, analysis and report writing.
- Sound understanding of the key issues and challenges related to the exercise of 'Focused Group Discussion' and interview and also hold the expertise to address them.
- Experience of innovative use of Technology, Information and Communication tools to facilitate sharing and dissemination.
- Manpower with the Communication skills in local language.
- Preferably should have a presence in the area.

In order to get the work moving ahead, the Agency would adhere to the following schedule and timeline:

- **Phase I: Initial Survey** - March 2013
- **Phase II: Intermediate Survey** – 2014-15
- **Phase III: Final Surveys** – 2016-17
